The Technology and Research Center (TFZ) at the Technopol Wiener Neustadt is home to scientific facilities such as three COMET competence centers, an institute of the Austrian Academy of Sciences, a department of the Austrian Institute of Technology, the R&D subsidiaries of the University of Applied Sciences, the surface technology department of the ofi Austrian Research Institute for Chemistry and Technology as well as other R&D institutions and high-tech companies. At present, around 350 highly-qualified scientists are working at this specially designed facility, addressing the challenges of modern science and technology.

The TFZ is remarkably international: researchers from over than 20 and students from over 60 countries work at the Technopol (TFZ, University of Applied Sciences

Available Space

- The TFZ has been built and expanded step by step with its occupants. With a gross floor area of 19,000 m² (approx. 204,500 f²), around 11,600 m² (124,900 f²) are available for lease as lab or office space. To meet the steady demand for additional space, a custom expansion is set to take place in 2011 to create an additional 4,300 m² (approx. 46,300 f²) space.

Location and Access to Means of Transportation

- Excellent accessibility by rail and bus; central rail station directly on the South line; bus routes G and the FH-Express
- Very good access to A2 South Autobahn
- S6 Semmering highway and S4 Burgenland highway
- Directly adjacent to Wiener Neustadt airfields LOAN and LOXN
- Distances: Vienna: 50 km, Graz: 150 km, Hungarian border (Klingenbach): 35 km, Bratislava: 112 km, Sopron: 42 km
